A Greek School Committee*, comprised of the Priest, Greek School Teacher, Parish Council Liaison and PTO representative(s) was organized, with the approval of the St. Anthony Parish Council.

*The role of the Greek School Committee is to recommend and implement the Guidelines and Regulations which follow and also to serve administratively in Greek School issues.

Time, days and location of 2017-2018 Greek School Year:

The Greek School year for 2017-2018 will start September 18, 2018 and conclude in May 14, 2019.
Greek School will be held in the church basement on Tuesday evenings from 5:30-6:15 pm (Group A)
6:30-8:00 pm weekly (for Group B). Groups to be determined.

Tuition:

Stewards of the Church: \$250 for the 1st child, \$225 for the 2nd child and \$200 for the 3rd child.
Non-stewards of the Church: \$400 for the 1st child and \$25 less for additional children.
There will be a \$25 registration fee (per family) due at the time of registration.
The registration fee will be used to purchase additional textbooks and small stipends for classroom supplies.

Textbooks

Student will be using the textbooks and materials of the Greek Orthodox Archdioceses of America, Department of Greek Education.

Guidelines & Regulations:

1. Please arrive on time each day, be prepared with the necessary school materials and be sure your child/children have the correct book(s), notebook(s) and homework assignments with them.
2. Please be advised the doors to the Church will be locked during class hours to ensure your child(s) safety. Please contact the teacher via text to alert her when you are there and/or if you are picking up your child early.
3. Parents, please be on time to pick up your child/children at the end of their class. Please notify/contact the teacher if someone other than yourself is picking up your child/children to ensure their safety.
4. Parents, please make sure all disruptive devices are left at home. This includes: iPads, cellphones and toys. The school is not responsible for damages to items brought to school.
5. Food, snacks and candy are not permitted in the classroom. Your child may only bring a water bottle.
6. Parents/visitors please do not sit in the classroom while lessons are taking place. Excessive noise and disruption caused by others impede the learning process.
7. If you have any immediate questions or concerns that you need to speak to the teacher about, please email the teacher or contact a member of the Greek School Committee. Mrs. Gerakios will be happy to schedule a time to meet with you in person or with the Greek School Committee.
8. Please make every effort to attend mandatory practices for ethnic celebrations. Your attendance is crucial to our success.
9. Please respond to Mrs. Gerakios when she sends communications.

Policy and Procedure for misbehavior, excessive tardiness/absences, coming to class unprepared, grievances and late pick-ups:

1st incident: The teacher will speak to the child.

2nd incident: The Priest and the teacher will speak to the child and the parent.

3rd incident: The child, along with the parent will meet with the Greek School Committee. The decision of the Greek School Committee will be final.
