Every year, on Clean Monday, comes the time to make laganas (that's the plural form of the word lagana). Laganas are a type of crunchy, semi leavened bread that's eaten by Greeks only once a year, on Clean Monday. That day ushers in the Greek Orthodox Great Lent, which lasts about 40 days. For those who observe it, Lent is a period of fasting, reflecting, and repenting. It ends on the movable feast that is Easter Sunday.
